**RE: PIN 6805.56 Element Specific Railroad Work
Interstate 99 – Exit 8 Erwin/Addison
Town of Erwin, Steuben County**

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) would like to notify you of an upcoming bridge rehabilitation project in your community. Project Identification Number (PIN) 6805.56 will address conditions at the bridges carrying Interstate 99 over the Norfolk Southern Railroad about 1600 feet north of State Route 417 in the town of Erwin, Steuben County.

The 2022 construction season project will involve repairing the concrete substructure, steel girder ends, deck edges and replacing the bridge rail with concrete barrier to extend the life of the bridge.

To construct this project, we will need to reduce I-99 to a single lane of traffic in both the southbound and northbound directions. To safely accomplish this, the on-ramp to I-99 north at Exit 8 will also be closed. A detour will be in place guiding motorists to use State Route 417 to access I-99.

Construction is anticipated to be completed by the end of October, weather dependent.
