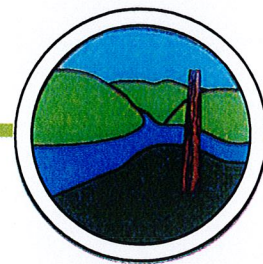

**ERWIN ANNOUNCES LEAF PICK-UP BEGINS**

**SATURDAY YARD WASTE DROP-OFF ENDS**

Painted Post, N.Y., October 21 – The Saturday Yard Waste drop-off will end next Saturday, October 28, 2017. The drop-off for grass clippings and yard waste at the site on Route 417 west of Sirianni Hardwood and Corning Incorporated's CMS facility, will be open this Saturday from 9:00 am to noon. October 21 and October 28 are the last days for drop-off. The Town's semi-annual roadside brush pick-up was completed in September. The next roadside pick-up will be in the Spring of 2018. No yard waste may be left at the roadside.

The leaf pick-up will begin Monday, October 23 and will continue through November 17, 2017. **NO BAGS PLEASE.** Leaves will not be picked up in bags. Residents are asked to rake their leaves to the roadside. Leaves must *not* be placed in the road, gutters or over catch basins or other drainage structures. Observing this rule will enhance safety for residents using Town roads, reduce the risk from flooding, and reduce damage to Town storm drainage structures such as ditches, gutters and catch basins.

The Town of Erwin is a community of distinction that covers 36-square-miles, and includes Coopers Plains, Long Acres, Twin Valley, Gang Mills and the Village of Painted Post; and neighboring farms, businesses, factories and state forests. Town of Erwin population totals 8,000.
