

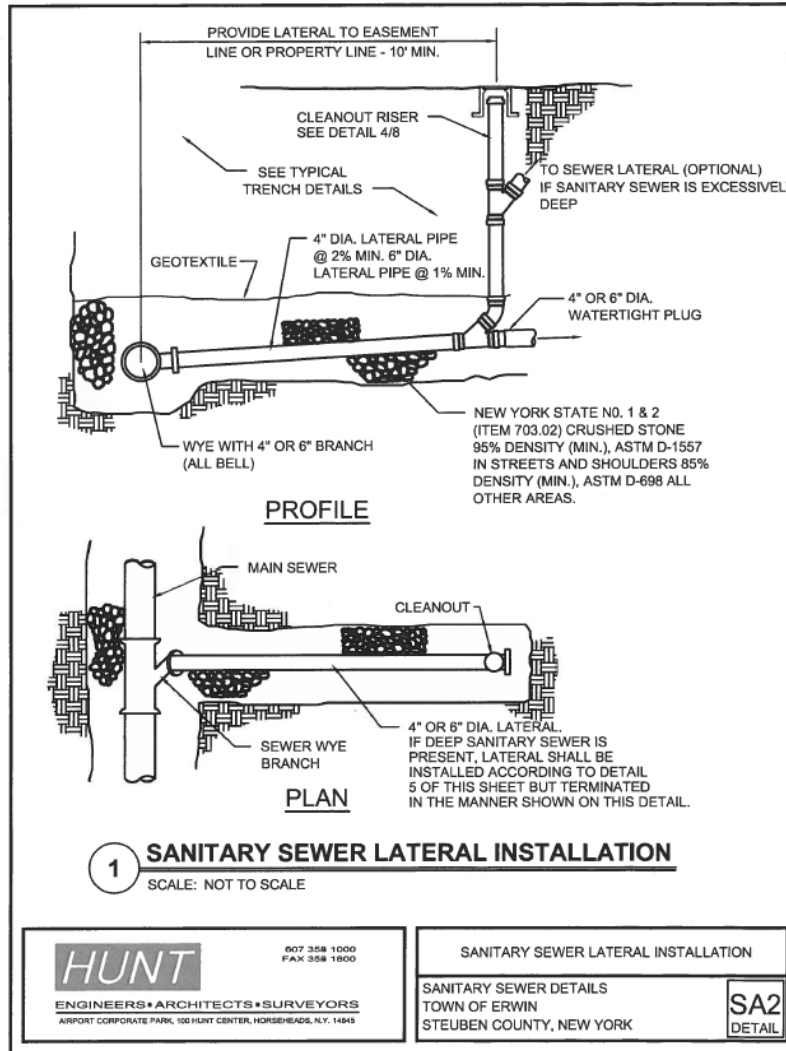
Sewer Service - Property Owner's Responsibilities

- Secure Contractor
- Complete Permit Application for Sewer Connection - \$50 fee will be waived for this district until Dec 2017
- Installation of sewer service from the connection point to building
- Abandon the existing Septic Tank for property owner's protection
- Purchase any fittings necessary for sewer lateral connection installation
- Electrical Connection and proper service for pump station if required.

Sewer Service – Lateral Pipe Specs

- PVC Pipe shall be schedule 40/SDR 21 or greater supplied in 18 foot lengths. The pipe may be joined by elastomeric gaskets.
- Ductile Iron Pipe shall be used for sanitary sewer with services with less than 3 feet of cover or in excess of 20 feet of cover.
- **NO UNDERGROUND PIPING SHALL BE BURIED OR BACK – FILLED UNTIL IT HAS BEEN INSPECTED BY THE TOWN SEWER DEPT. 24 HR NOTICE IN REQUIRED FOR THE INSPECTION!**

Sewer Services - Application & Town Ordinance

- Property owner or their contractor shall complete a Sewer Service Permit Application at the Town Hall. Application fee of \$50 waived until December 2017.
- Town Septic Tank Abandonment requirements are included in the handout and attached to the Sewer Service Permit Application.
- If a Property Owner wants to reuse their dry well for roof drains, sump pump or ground water discharge, they must note this in their permit request.
- Property owner/contractor shall be familiar with Town's sewer service requirements

Sewer Services – Septic Abandonment

- Town of Erwin septic tank abandonment procedures are summarized as follows:
 - Remove all obstructions from the septic tank.
 - Have the septic tank contents pumped clean and disposed of by a licensed septic hauler, as required NYS Dept of Health.
 - Remove or Completely Crush in tank cover and Backfill the tank with flowable fill (grout) or pea stone to the top of the existing tank walls
 - The Town will not allow the reuse of Septic Tanks for Pump Station Wet Wells. The Pump Stations are self contained.
 - **NOTIFY THE TOWN WHEN THE SEPTIC TANK ABANDONMENT IS TO BE PERFORMED FOR INSPECTION BY THE SEWER DEPT 24 HOURS BEFORE.**

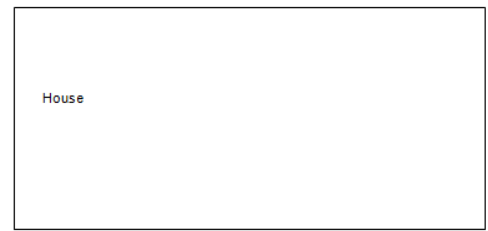

Sewer Services – Dry Well Use

- A Property Owner choosing to retain their existing dry well shall be responsible for installing a separate connection to the dry well for their roof drains, sump pump(s) discharge, ground water or other non waste water connections
- This must be stated in the Sewer Service Application Form for Town Approval.
- **SUMP PUMPS, GUTTERS AND SURFACE DRAINS CANNOT BE CONNECTED TO THE TOWN SEWER LINE – NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Sewer Services – Dry Well Use

☐ Property Owner is responsible for the following:

- Include in Permit Application
- Installing piping and have tested by a Licensed Plumber
- **Have Piping inspected by the Town Sewer Operator before backfilling, 24 hr notice required.**
- Subject to future inspection as part of Sewer Use Ordinance.
